

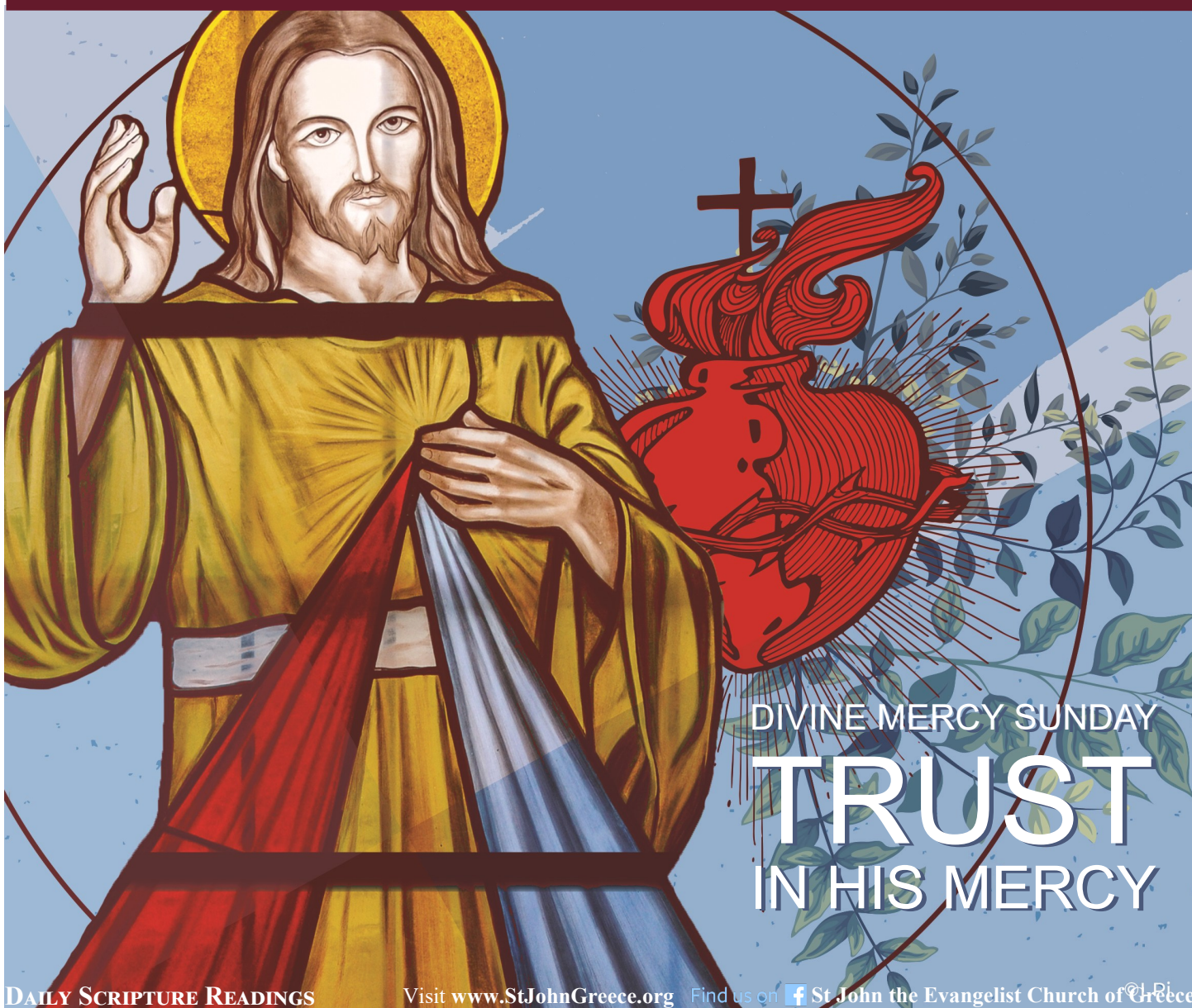

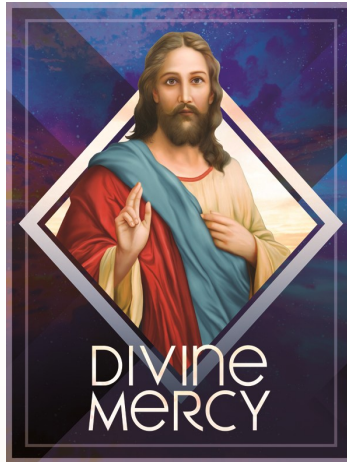
## Welcome!

### God's Mercy Endures Forever

This Sunday we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. In the opening prayer of today's Mass, we address God as God of Mercy and our Scripture readings echo this theme. The Apostles acted in the name of Jesus when they showed mercy to the sick and troubled who were brought to them.

The message of Divine Mercy, as found in the writing of Saint Faustina, is a simple one: God's love and mercy are greater than sin; we can trust him to have mercy on us when we call out to him and, because we experience God's mercy in our lives, we can be merciful to others. It was through private revelations from Jesus to Saint Faustina that the Church, during the papacy of St John Paul, declared the Sunday after Easter to be a day dedicated to the tremendous blessing of God's mercy shown to us through Jesus. Some people would like to ignore the reality of sin in the world and believe that Jesus Christ took away all sin forever on Calvary. Indeed, we do believe that the death of Jesus *made satisfaction for our sins to the father* CC615 *and by his sacrifice he pours out the graces of salvation on his church* CC1407. However, we must remember that through God's gift of free will we can reject the



grace that Christ won for us on the Cross, thus we can choose to embrace a sinful way of living. It is only with God's grace and mercy that we can continue to fight against evil in the world and in our own lives.

Through Baptism we each became a recipient of God's mercy in a special way. Sin no longer had any claim on us as we became members of the body of Christ. In the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick, God continues to share his

mercy and forgiveness with us. We also acknowledge our trust on God's mercy when we come together for the celebration of our Eucharistic liturgy. Think about the prayers of the penitential rite: *Lord have mercy. Christ have mercy. Lord have mercy.* Today think about the trust we express when we ask God for our needs in the prayers of the faithful. Let us today think about our plea for mercy and peace at the Lamb of God. Each day this week we can make the words of the psalmist our own. *Give thanks to the Lord, for his is good, for his mercy endures*

*forever. Alleluia! Ps 118:1*

Read Blvd.** The afternoon will consist of Chanting the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, and the Sacrament of Reconciliation. **Key Spiritual Benefits and Graces of Divine Mercy Sunday**

- **Total Remission of Sin and Punishment:** Jesus promised that any soul that goes to Confession and receives Holy Communion on this day will obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. This means not only are sins forgiven, but the punishment typically associated with them is erased.
- **“Second Baptism” Effect:** The grace of this day is described as a complete renewal of baptismal grace, restoring the soul to a state of innocence.
- **An “Ocean of Graces”:** Jesus indicated that all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened on this day, offering profound mercy for all, especially sinners.
- **Refuge and Shelter:** The feast serves as a special refuge for souls, providing immense comfort to those suffering from the weight of sins and despair.
- **Comfort and Hope:** Divine Mercy Sunday reinforces that no matter how severe the sins, God’s mercy is greater, offering a, “consolation of the whole world”.

**To Receive These Extraordinary Graces, Believers are to:**

1. **Celebrate the Feast** on the Sunday after Easter.
2. **Go to Confession** (on or shortly before the day).
3. **Repent** and sincerely trust in God’s mercy.
4. **Receive Holy Communion** on Divine Mercy Sunday.
5. **Show acts of mercy** through actions, words, or prayers for others.





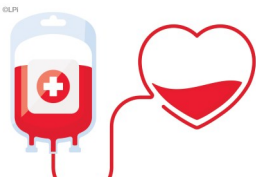

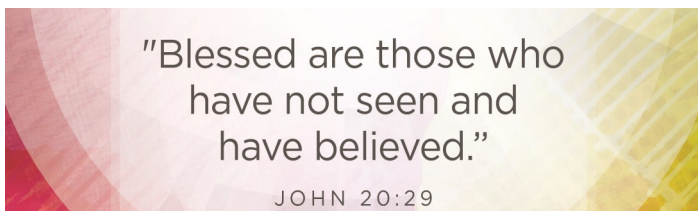

**CMA UPDATE:** Our Goal for this year is set at \$80,000, which is higher than last year.

**CHAIRPERSON POSITION:** I have been the Chairperson for the Parish Council for six (6) years, and I have one (1) year left for my term as a council member. I have discussed with Father Peter that I think it is time for some "NEW BLOOD" in the Chairperson Position. I will still be on the council to help the new Chairperson get their feet wet. Father Peter has reached out to one of our members and after a couple of discussions and some soul-searching and some arm twisting, Nick Verdino has agreed to step up the plate, and he has accepted the position of Parish Council Chairperson. So, after our June Council meeting, Nick will take over as Chairperson. Congratulations Nick and Thank you.

**PROCEDURES/BACKUPS:** Initially, I requested Backup person names and procedures from 36 Ministries. I know there are more, but this task is pretty big and I know I will be requesting more.

1. **Ministry Backups** – I have received the names of 18 backup People. Still a lot to go. Are the things that are still being stored on the property still being used by active ministries? If there are things that can be donated or thrown away we should review these things and free up some storage.

1. **Event procedures** – I have received the procedures from 18 different ministries so far. I need some attention given to this from the leaders. These will all be kept as hard copy and an electronic file in the Rectory.

**RocCatholicNW website:** We are still looking for a person from St. John's to review our content on this website and be willing to update it.

**Certificate of Appreciation:** No nominations pending, currently.
