



## Now & Forever is a Profession of Faith

The task of renewal of our Catholic faith in this parish is our responsibility, each and every one of us. Every baptized member is called forth to be a witness of Christ in our family, at work, and in the community. Certainly the task of renewal will require changes in our thinking about the Catholic faith, structures, and organizational life of our beloved St John's parish.

As Catholics we can no longer allow ourselves the complacency of the past. The way things have always been needs to become the way things need to be. If we have any hope of preaching Jesus Christ to the world around us here in Greece and beyond, then we need to stand up for our faith. We need to proclaim God's love for us in our family. We need to make room for the love of God to transform our lives so that we can put Christ first. In doing this we will be able to love God and neighbor as well as make sure our Sunday obligation becomes part of our everyday life. Finally, we need to announce to the whole world our love for our Catholic faith despite its human imperfections. In the years ahead as we grow together we need to speak the truth to each other with charity and respect—but also candidly. This should be the spirit that should animate every level of our Church life. In the words of Archbishop Charles Caput of Philadelphia: No one “owns the Church, not the bishops, not the

clergy, and not the people. The Church belongs to Jesus Christ and to Him alone.” We are all called by our baptism to service in this Church and as St. Paul says, we are called to the different ministries in the Church to make God's kingdom grow. You and I are needed to build this Church of Christ founded on the apostles, which is now our turn to uphold. We are the driving force behind the function of the body of Christ, the Church.

We are never alone, God is always with us. As we are with God, we are one with each other. As we go through each day, let us pray to be guided by the Holy Spirit. Let us go forth now and forever with the realization we are never alone; let us smile at the stranger in the pew and offer the sign of peace. Let our worship show by word and deed that God is with us. When we recite our Profession of Faith, may it be one that we truly believe and put into action in our lives. *God bless us all,*





## Our Corporal Works of Mercy – Feeding the Hungry – Making an Impact

We recently received a note from Chris Pucher, Assistant Treasurer at the Greece Ecumenical Food Shelf & Clothing Closet, thanking the congregation of St. John's for the numerous food and monetary donations we made during 2025.

They tallied our food donations which amounted to 1,857 pounds of food!

It was pointed out that in 2025, with the support GEFS received from the ENTIRE Greece community, they were able to serve 4,868 households or 14,807 clients at the Food Shelf, distributing 356,530 pounds of food. The Clothing Closet served 1,723 households. As you can see from these numbers, this is a LOT of help St. John's, together with the entire Greece Community, has provided in serving our neighbors who are facing food and clothing insecurity in the Town of Greece and the Charlotte neighborhood.

We will continue in 2026 to hold periodic food drives here at St. John's in an ongoing effort to offer support to our brothers and sisters in need who are assisted through GEFS. May God continue to bless us one and all!

## LENT 2026 *The Heart of Jesus*



### Mass & Distribution of Ashes at St. John's on Ash Wednesday, February 18

Mass & Distribution of Ashes at 7:00 AM, 9:00 AM, 12:05 PM,

*The act of putting on ashes symbolizes fragility and mortality, and the need to be redeemed by the mercy of God. Far from being a merely external act, the Church has retained the use of ashes to symbolize that attitude of internal penance to which all the baptized are called during Lent.*

Ashes will be imposed in the traditional manner, making the Sign of the Cross with the thumb on the foreheads of the faithful, while praying each time: "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return", or "Repent, and believe in the Gospel."

### Our Lenten Sacrifice

**Days of Abstinence:** On Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent, and Good Friday—No meat can be taken by all who have reached their 14th birthday.

**Days of Fast:** On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday—A limit of one full meatless meal for all who have reached their 18th birthday and have not as yet reached their 60th birthday. *Sufficient food is allowed at other meal times to sustain strength. No eating between meals. These regulations ought to be observed by all Catholics unless there is a truly important reason, such as health, that prevents their observance. While no dispensation is needed in these cases, a substitute Act of Penance (fasting, prayer, or act of charity) should be done.*

**Weekdays of Lent:** No obligation to fast, however, voluntary acts of self-denial are recommended

**Easter Duty Obligation:** Must be made from First Sunday in Lent (February 22) through Trinity Sunday (May 31)

**Self-Denial:** This is encouraged on a voluntary basis. Acts may include daily Mass, spiritual study, Lenten Devotions, the Rosary, Stations of the Cross, and deeds of mercy and kindness.






