Epiphany

In western Christian tradition, January is celebrated as Epiphany. It goes by other names in various church traditions. In the Hispanic and Latin culture, as well as in some places in Europe, it is know as Three Kings' day.

Christmas celebrates a family that could not get a place to stay. A family that was

homeless, with no place at the Inn. Mary had to give birth in a stable. The angels came and glorified God. Then the people of the East came and found the wonder child that King Herod had sought to eliminate because he felt Jesus was a threat to his parochial sense of kingdom.






Let Heaven and Nature Sing!

A Way to Honor the Holy Name of Jesus

I was raised in the South; Louisville, KY, where we were taught from an early age, through school and by my parents, that one always bows his/her head

at the name of Jesus! Southern folks, at least when I grew up there, were very polite and respectful in many ways. The one thing I have always remembered and have tried to adhere to is demonstrating respect by bowing my head at both the sound of HIS (JESUS'S) name and in my silent prayer.

This has been a longstanding tradition and in this day and age, as we make manifest the Holy Name of Jesus, let us consider this simple, yet profound, gesture.

"Because of this, God greatly exalted Him and bestowed on Him the name that is above every name, 10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend, of those in heaven and on earth and under the earth, 11 and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father." Philippians 2: 9,10,11

I hope my thoughts will serve as a gentle reminder or perhaps a new suggestion. Our trust should always remain in Jesus. By pausing at the mention of His name, bowing our heads in our quiet as well as spoken prayer, I believe, serves as an extra sign of gratitude toward Him who sacrificed so greatly for us all. There is no doubt in my mind that JESUS would be pleased if more of His children would show their love and honor for Him by this small gesture.

Please consider passing on this tradition to your children and grandchildren as you have opportunity to do so.

Sunday, January 8 The Epiphany

First Reading Is 60:1-6

Rise up in splendor, Jerusalem! Your light has come, the glory of the Lord shines upon you. Assembling all the chief priests and the scribes of the people, He inquired of them where the Christ was to be born. They said to him, "In Bethlehem of Judea, for thus it has been written through the prophet:

And you, Bethlehem, land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; since from you shall come a ruler, who is to shepherd my people Israel."

Then Herod called the magi secretly and ascertained from them the time of the star's appearance. He sent them to Bethlehem and said, "Go and search diligently for the child. When you have found him, bring me word, that I too may go and do him homage." After their audience with the king they set out. And behold, the star that they had seen at its rising preceded them, until it came and stopped over the place where the child was. They were overjoyed at seeing the star, and on entering the house they saw the child with Mary his mother. They prostrated themselves and did him homage. Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh. And having been warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they departed for their country by another way.


