

Let the Lord Cultivate the Ground of Faith

We need to know that our God is a God of consolation and love. He is always encouraging us. God never gives up on us. He never condemns or rejects us. The church is all of us. We are called to be the everyday Christian as we make the effort to renew our relationship with God during this Lenten time. Researchers tell us that in our society today about three out of every ten people who were baptized Catholic go to Mass weekly. If we count those who go twice or three times a month, the number increases, but the reality is that about half the people baptized into our faith no longer attend Mass. Some still consider themselves Catholic, and some do not. Many have drifted away from the church for so long that they seem lost. Like recently, a person asked me, "Father, I have not been to church for so long; I am Catholic. Would God forgive me?" The person has since died. God never forgets anyone, and welcomes all at any moment into his presence. Jesus, like water, sustains, nourishes, renews, and uplifts us. Jesus wants us to worship together in faith. There is no doubt that one of the challenges facing the Church is that in our world today,



people do not believe much of anything. There is too much self-sufficiency; too much I don't need God; too much I am not interested; and those in power have structured society in such a way as to make it very difficult to live humanely, let alone in a Christian way. So let us not be

afraid to be ourselves with God. Today's society faces a crisis of faith that can only be solved by responding to the personal call to conversion. Let us have time for the Sacrament of Reconciliation to experience the compassion of our God, and let it move us to share this compassion with everyone we meet.

Victory belongs to God's anointed. Jesus Christ will cultivate the ground of faith for all His people. In the end, we become a sign of the way things will be in heaven, "when every tear will be wiped away," and everyone will be treated with respect and as equals. Even now, Jesus is waiting to talk with us about everything and anything. Why wait? Let us seek him, hear His word, and fall in love with Him again.



The next time for scheduling Mass Intentions here at St. John's will begin by telephone THIS Wednesday, **March 25, 2026, from 9 AM till 1 PM.** This will include scheduling Masses during the months of May, 2026 through August, 2026.

Please know that this is not the only day you can call to schedule but it is the first day you can begin scheduling. This first day, March 25, will be by telephone only (please, no walk-ins on this first day). After March 25, you may call or stop at the Parish Office during office hours to schedule.

We will follow the same guidelines with the scheduling of 1 or 2 Masses. If you are looking to schedule 2 Masses, please know that **at least one** of the two will need to be scheduled at an 8:15 morning Mass. While we try to accommodate your Mass date requests, this is not always possible and we appreciate your understanding and flexibility when necessary.

PLEASE NOTE: We still have unscheduled Masses for those who have received Mass Cards for their deceased relatives and/or friends. Please call the office to arrange for these Masses to be scheduled. If we do not hear from someone by April 10, we will go ahead and schedule the Mass(es) and you can look for it in the *Masses for the Week* section in our bulletin. Thank you.



Good Friday Prayer Service and Stations of the Cross in Reparation for Abortion






