




## Welcome!

If you are new in the parish, we invite you to become a member of our faith community where we come together to worship the Lord and celebrate the Eucharist. We want to get to know you and recognize there are some challenges in doing so during Covid-19, however, if you can introduce yourself after Mass, we will be grateful. ### The Penitential Rite

After the opening greeting at Mass, we have a PENITENTIAL RITE so that we as a people would recognize God's mercy in the face of our sinfulness. Our prayers show God and ourselves that we are in the process of converting and that we are in need of reconciliation with God and others.

When the Presider (the priest who is leading the Mass) says, "Let us call to mind our sins and ask for God's mercy," it is a time for us to personally ask God to forgive anything we have done wrong or something good we failed to do. We then speak words together which either show that we as a people have sinned ("I confess to Almighty God



and to you my brothers and sisters...etc.) or words that proclaim God's mercy (Lord have mercy") Like the sign of peace, this moment of mercy makes us think of Jesus' words, "If you bring your gifts to the altar and you recall that you are angry at your brother or sister, first go and make peace with him or her, then come and offer your gifts." This moment of mercy at the start of Mass is a strong interior moment that leads to peace with God and peace with one another. So please, now that you know what happens at the



penitential rite, kindly avail yourself to the flow of the Spirit within you. With peace and love to all,

### St. Joseph Table


Join us on Sunday, March 15 in the Parish Center after the 10:00 AM Mass for this Italian Tradition.





### Something to Contemplate and Pray About During Lent Which GAME Do You Value the Most?

A football coach commands that if you want to play in the game, you better show up to all the practices unless you are really sick. No excuses. He wants you there with all enthusiasm and love for the game. He wants you to give him your all! The majority of players will show up, some even if they are sick, as playing in the game is that important to them.

God also commands us "to show up on Sundays (unless you are sick) if you want to "play well in the game (of life)." He wants you there with all enthusiasm and love, He wants YOU to give Him your all!

The coach has a strategy to win? He has a "game plan" for each player according to his ability. If the player doesn't follow directions and does his own thing, he could be thrown out of the game. Some players are capable of "more plays." Some can do only a few...but do them very well!



God has a strategy to win also. He has "TEN" of them if you want to "Play in the Game". If His players don't follow these "TEN" and do their own thing, the players could be "thrown out of the game". Some "players" are capable of "more plays." Some can do only a few...but do them very well!

As a coach, if a player messes up big time and repeatedly, it's very likely he's done! Not so for God. If a player messes up big time and repeatedly, there is a way to get "back into the game." It's called the

confessional. It's a new start and God gives His "players" the grace they need to keep playing well!

The football players who win the game receive a trophy that will be treasured for a time but God's players that "win the game" receive a trophy that will be treasured forever...Eternally!


