





### Lent is a Better Time for Life

The things that concern us and keep our minds preoccupied are not superficial matters, they are integral parts of our lives and we need to tend to them. We can use some help to keep us focused and guide our decisions. While we know there are no easy and quick solutions to the important issues we face, we do want to keep our heads about us. The Lenten season is a time to do it.

The signs and symbols of Lent are meant to help us focus our attention on the great mysteries that will be celebrated in a few weeks.

This Lent, make an extra effort to attend daily Mass, spend some time before the Blessed Sacrament, pray the Stations of the Cross, and make little acts of sacrifice.



This Lent, let us avoid telling ourselves there is no time for prayer. Be inventive and find a few moments for prayer each day. Let us resolve to offer something to God's glory. Fasting has been called "the prayer of the body." When we deny ourselves some small pleasure, we almost automatically become attentive to things that really matter, like our relationship with God. Lent is also a time of repentance. After all, as we try to draw closer to the Lord, we will inevitably uncover areas in our lives that need forgiveness. This is the reason why the Sacrament of Reconciliation is central to the season.



Have a peaceful season of Lent.



### First Scrutiny, March 8, 2026

#### What are the Scrutinies?

The Scrutinies are Rites celebrated on the Third, Fourth, and Fifth Sundays of Lent, by those who are preparing to be **baptized at Easter**, known as "The Elect". This year we, here at St. John's, are blessed with **Hunter Drake as our Elect**.

The Scrutinies are described by the Church as "rites for self-searching and repentance which are meant to uncover, then heal, all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the elect; to bring out, then strengthen all that is upright, strong and good. The Scrutinies are celebrated in order to deliver the elect from the power of sin and Satan, to protect them against temptation, and to give them strength in Christ who is *the Way, the Truth and the Life*."



These rites, therefore, should complete the conversion of the elect and deepen their resolve to hold fast to Christ and to carry out their decision to love God above all."

The Gospels on the three Sundays on which the Scrutinies are celebrated (March 8, March 15, and March 22, 2026), teach the elect about the mystery of sin and fill them with the Spirit of Christ.

The first Gospel (March 8), The Samaritan Woman at the Well, tells us that Christ is the Living Water.

The second Gospel (March 15), The Healing of the Man Born Blind, tells us that Christ is the Light of the World.

The third Gospel (March 22), The Raising of Lazarus from the Dead, tells us that Christ is the Resurrection and the Life.



### Preparing for the 10th Bishop of the Diocese of Rochester – Bishop-Designate John S. Bonnici



With much anticipation, we prepare for the installation of Bishop-Designate John S. Bonnici as the 10th bishop of the Diocese of Rochester. **The Diocese of Rochester has announced that the installation of Bishop-Designate John S. Bonnici will take place during a 2:00 PM Mass at Sacred Heart Cathedral on March 19, 2026,**

**the Solemnity of St. Joseph.** Admission to the Mass will be by ticket only, however, livestream coverage of the Mass will be available via the Catholic Courier’s website, *CatholicCourier.com* and we encourage you to take part in this livestreaming.

Bishop Bonnici, currently an auxiliary bishop of the Archdiocese of New York, was named by Pope Leo XIV as the 10th bishop of the Diocese of Rochester on January 7, 2026. He will be installed as the successor to Bishop Salvatore R. Matano, who has led the Diocese of Rochester since 2014. Bishop Bonnici was ordained to the sacred priesthood at St. Patrick’s Cathedral for the Archdiocese of New York by Cardinal John O’Connor on June 22, 1991, the Feast of Sts. John Fisher and Thomas More– the patron saints of the Diocese of Rochester – what a connection!

Let us continue to pray for one another and in a special way for Bishop-Designate Bonnici, that God may grant him all the graces he needs to faithfully carry out this Ministry entrusted to his care. In the days leading up to this very special and holy occasion, let us please offer the following prayer, through the intercession of St. Joseph and Sts. John Fisher and Thomas More.

Praise to you, Lord our God, our Eternal Shepherd and Guide, who has chosen your servant, John Bonnici, as the 10th Bishop of the Diocese of Rochester.
