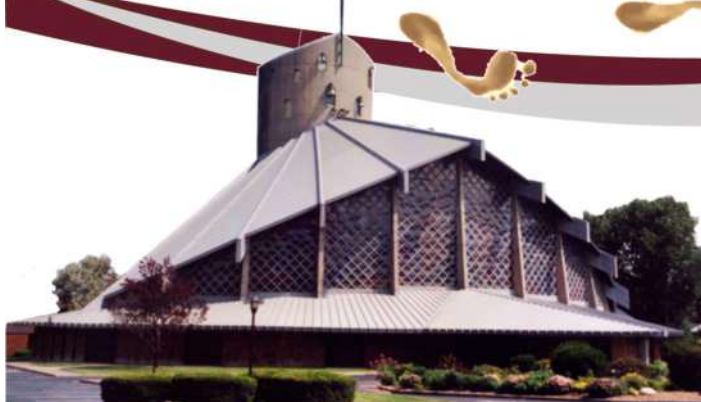

October – The Month of the Rosary

As you may know, the Catholic Church devotes the month of October as *The Month of the Rosary*. For those who may not know, 1/2 hour before the start of each weekend Mass, the Rosary is prayed in the pews in front of the Blessed Sacrament. On Saturday this begins at 3:30 PM and on Sunday it begins at 7:30 AM and 9:30 AM. Compared to the attendance at each Mass, there is only a very small group of people who partakes in this group prayer. We'd certainly like to see more people take part and so would our Blessed Mother. You are not required to lead a decade of the Rosary but you can certainly volunteer to do so. Anyone not leading the decade, you would simply join the others in the prayers of the Rosary.

Pamphlets are available for those who may not be familiar with praying the Rosary and there is always someone who can help you in learning how to do so. Now is wonderful time to do so!

We also bring to your attention our **Fatima Women's Prayer Ministry** led by Eileen Zegarelli. We are a group of women who meet once a month to faith share with the focus on

our Blessed Mother and praying the Rosary. We gather in the Parish Center where Eileen guides us in deepening our understanding of the story of Fatima as well as various topics surrounding Our Lady. We also share prayer intentions anyone would like us to pray for. After this, we go over to Church and our group prays the Rosary offering our intentions in front of the Blessed Sacrament in the Tabernacle. We are always open to women joining our group so whether you're a longstanding parishioner, someone new, or anywhere in between, know that you are welcome to join us – we'd love to have you! 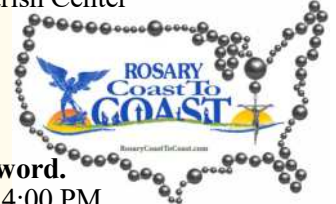

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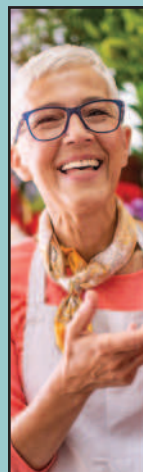
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
